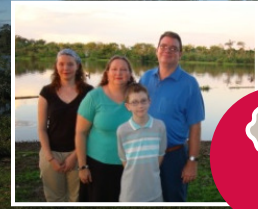

Dear Friends,

It seems hard to believe we have been here almost twenty years. The end of October we officially celebrate this anniversary. Thank you for upholding us these many years in prayer, and for allowing us to be your “arm of service” in the jungles of the Amazon Basin.

This month we’d like to start a series called, “Meet Our Flight Clients”. Our first featured client is the Swiss Mission in Peru, known to us as “Mision Suiza en el Peru”, or “MSP” for short. These folks are our neighbors who live about two miles up the road. The Swiss Mission, funded by a variety of evangelical believers and churches in Switzerland and Germany, has been here since the 1950’s. Its purpose is to train and equip pastors and Christian workers, especially those from ethnic groups living in the jungle. These workers will then be able to share the Gospel with those of their own villages, as well as those of other native Peruvian ethnic groups. To accomplish this goal, the MSP hosts two study cycles a year at their base, which becomes, for those four months, a Native Bible Institute.

Also we’d like to invite you to meet Marcos Bardales Puricho, his wife Yolanda and Mateo Roque Tachiana, his wife Maria, and their son Claus (pictured here). Both of these families are from the Junikuin ethnic group that lives near the western border of Brazil. SAMAIR Peru had the privilege of returning them safely



to their village the first week of August. There they will share the Gospel with their fellow tribesmen.

Mike is currently working on exporting engines that need overhauled for SAMAIR Peru use next year. Pray for him as he works with customs agents and officials to get this done quickly.
