Mike is serving as office manager. Working with part-time secretaries and some other volunteers has made that job different than it was in the past. He has taken over importing parts, and plans to try several new methods of getting aircraft parts through the customs process.

The 10,000-hour inspection on one of the wheel planes has been progressing slowly. Some of the control surfaces are now painted. A crack in a major component was discovered two weeks ago; we are expecting the replacement parts to arrive soon. Please continue to pray that the plane will be completed in a timely and efficient manor and the project will be fully funded. We are short about \$10,000 for the completion of the project, since replacement parts for needed repair have exceeded original estimates.

We would like to update you and thank you for your prayers for us since November. First, my (Nancy's mother) went to be with the Lord on November 13, after only a six-week illness. She had her mind and her health and lived in her own home until September 26; she was 90 years old. Truly, God blessed her and our family mightily.

Two weeks after Mom passed away, Mike and I received our resident visas and official documents again. Our shipment arrived December 9 and we can now finally say we are settled. Although we are about six weeks behind in our children's home-school schedule, we are working hard to catch up. My job is to facilitate their learning, grade their work, and keep things focused and on track; I think the latter is the most difficult.
