IEP (Individualized Instruction Plan) and he is being served by the Special Education program. Annette has been classified as an exchange student for the school year. The second day of school she discovered a fellow MK classmate, so that has eased the difficulty of being in a large high school with 670 other students.

We are renting a lovely little house on a hill in the countryside near Coshocton. Three families in our neighborhood are with MMS Aviation, and have served overseas mission aviation organizations.

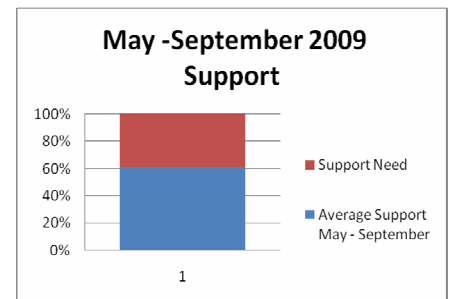

We also need about \$16,000 in outgoing expenses as well. This fund helps cover our return travel and document renewal expenses in Peru.
